Red is typically used for power, black is used for ground, blue is used for signal, and green is used for terminals. The IEC 60446 standard, "Basic and Safety Principles for Man-Machine Interface, Marking, and Identification," establishes global guidelines for identifying electrical equipment terminals, conductors, and wiring colors. A red button, a yellow stripe and a green sign can guide decisions in seconds, even when it is loud, rushed and chaotic. Yet, the way colors are used needs to be consistent. If a site uses the same color to mean two different things. A forklift whirs past as a warning light flashes, a bold red sign halts movement at a restricted zone, and a bright green arrow guides employees to an emergency exit. The Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) and the American National Standards Institute (ANSI) developed a standardized system in which each color designates a specific hazard. The Electrical Appliances (Color Code) Regulations 1969 came into effect on 1 July 1969.
