- o MDF (Main Distribution Frame): Connects external service provider lines to internal building wiring.
- o IDF (Intermediate Distribution Frame): Connects various network segments within a building or campus. The EDF specifically focuses on active equipment interconnections, providing a bridge between the MDF/IDF and network devices .
