During wall construction, the reserved hole shall be about 20mm larger than the length and width of the distribution box. NEC Article 314 establishes requirements for the installation and use of electrical boxes, conduit bodies, fittings, and handhole enclosures. A conduit body is a removable-cover section of a conduit system that provides access at junctions or termination points. Check for proper IP/NEMA ratings and material quality. Practice good wiring: secure. The bolt length is generally the sum of the buried depth (75 ~ 150mm), the thickness of the box bottom plate, the thickness of nuts and washers, plus about 5mm "head allowance". For smaller distribution boxes, wood bricks can also be embedded at the installation position (embedded according to the. A distribution box is a low-voltage electrical enclosure that receives incoming power and distributes it safely to multiple outgoing circuits through protective and switching devices such as MCBs, RCDs, RCBOs, fuses, isolators, busbars, neutral bars, earth bars, and surge protective devices.
