Wiring colors in a distribution box indicate the function of each wire: live (line), neutral, or ground, following regional standards like NEC in the US and IEC in Europe.

Standard Wiring Colors

1. United States (NEC standards):

- o Live (Line/Hot): Any color except white, gray, green, or green/yellow. Commonly black, red, or blue for multi-phase systems.
 - o Neutral: White or gray.
 - o Ground (Protective Earth): Green, bare copper, or green with yellow stripe .
- ### 2. Europe and UK (IEC standards, including BS 7671):
- o Live (Line/Phase): Brown (single-phase) or brown, black, gray (three-phase).
 - o Neutral: Blue.
 - o Protective Earth: Green with yellow stripe .
- ### 3. DC Systems:
- o Positive (+): Red (common in battery and solar systems).
 - o Negative (-): Black or blue.
 - o Ground/Earth: Green or green/yellow .

Key Points for Distribution Boxes

- o Single-phase AC: Typically has one live, one neutral, and one ground wire.
- o Three-phase AC: Uses three live wires (phases), one neutral, and one ground. Phase colors vary by region; in IEC, brown, black, and gray are standard.
- o Labeling: Older installations may use outdated colors; always label wires when mixing old and new wiring .
- o Safety: Always test wires with a voltage tester before touching. Misidentifying wires can cause electric shock or equipment damage .
